When the carrier provides packing materials, ▲then any packing or unpacking done by the carrier, at any time, shall be charged for under Item 2050.

When the shipper provides packing materials, ▲ any packing or unpacking done by the carrier, at any time, shall be under 2560 – Labor Charges.

Calculation of distances shall be based on actual shipper origination address ▲to destination address using [www.googlemaps.com](http://www.googlemaps.com). All mileage based rates will be based on one-way, not round-trip miles.
